

JetBlue's Gateway University: An Established Route to First Officer



Launched in 2008, JetBlue's Gateway University is the longest-running program of any U.S. airline offering aviation college students a clear path to a first officer position at a major airline. Students majoring in approved flight programs at a JetBlue partner college or university can apply to Gateway University and earn a conditional job offer for a position as a first officer at JetBlue.

Apply and be accepted as a Gateway University participant and earn a conditional job offer for a position as a JetBlue First Officer.	Graduate from your approved flight program at a partner school. Serve as a certified flight instructor at your school for at least 500 hours of dual given.	Fly for Cape Air, JSX, Tradewind Aviation or an approved carrier to meet the flight time requirements. Complete your full commitment with the carrier (as applicable). Attend our jet transition course (as applicable).	Successfully complete all requirements to become a JetBlue first officer, including but not limited to a background check, drug/alcohol testing, PRIA review and Pilot Hiring Committee final approval.

Eligibility requirements:

All applicants must:

- Be a junior, senior, or flight instructor at one of our partner colleges/universities
- Must be legally eligible to work in the United States
- Must be able to obtain and maintain a First Class Medical Certificate
- Must be able to obtain a valid passport with the ability to travel in and out of the United States
- Must be able to demonstrate proficiency in reading, writing and speaking English
